The Zonta Club of Fredericksburg is part of a Global organization of executives and professionals working together to advance the status of women worldwide through service and advocacy. Our focus toward the mission has been to provide scholarships to women of Gillespie County and its adjoining counties (Blanco, Kendall, Kerr, Kimble, Llano, and Mason) for college or other training to enhance their professional opportunities. The Scholarship Committee of the Zonta Club of Fredericksburg accepts applications in the Spring; this year's deadline is March 31st, 2018.

General Eligibility Requirements:

- Applicant must be a female resident of Gillespie County or of an adjoining county: Blanco, Kendall, Kerr, Kimble, Llano, or Mason.
- Applicant must be a high-school senior or older who will be attending an accredited post-high-school educational institution (i.e. college, university, trade school, etc.)
- Scholarships are based in part on financial need.
- Grade point average will be considered.
- Consideration is given to whether the overall circumstances and plans of an applicant make achievement of her goals realistic.
