Letter from the President

Sisters,

International Women's Day/Rose Day on Friday reminded me of how we are so connected with all we do internationally with Zonta (out of our \$130 dues, \$91 go to international missions to do so many amazing projects). But how cool is it that our little club in the hill country also supports a child, Nicole, in a country that I'm guessing most of us have never been to. Because of us, she gets to leave the house each day and go to school.

Just imagine that in 2019 your dad passes, and your mom survives by selling at a market trying to support a houseful of children. You find yourself a less privileged girl with no chance of ever going to school—not only because your mom can't support you, but also because you are a girl, and the boys in the family will always come first in line for schooling. Without a tuition paid, you will work at your grandma's house doing house chores and then...what else? God only knows.

But a teacher whose children have been supported by Zonta Club Fredericksburg in the past is on the lookout for the Nicoles of the world. She gave us Annamercy in 2021 where without ZCF's support she would have dropped out of school. Now she is in nursing school! Currently, we are supporting Nicole Manyengavana through not only her lower education levels, but now also to her advanced: this year she plans to go to the University of Zimbabwe and study law! From a little girl who lost her dad, had a mother who couldn't support the family for schooling, to a confident student who is ready to become a lawyer. This is what we are about.

ZCF matters! We may not reach the multitude of girls that our international funds cover, but for one little girl in Harare, Zimbabwe, we made a difference. And she and her teacher mentor, Netsai, send messages of love and gratitude to the women of ZCF. I'm so proud to be a Zontian. And as I gathered and loved on some of my sisters at Pecan Grove Store on Friday, our Rose/International Women's Day, I was reminded just how much I adore each of you, and how together we make the world a better place for women and girls...one little girl at a time.

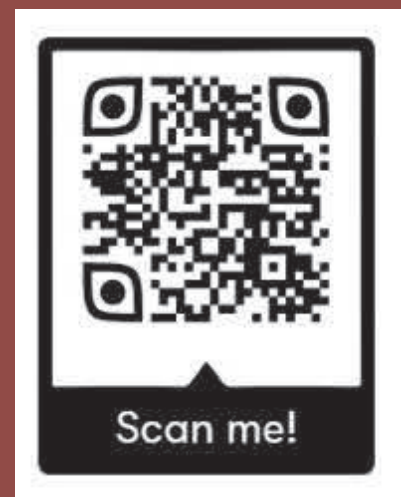

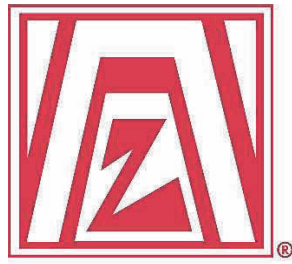
