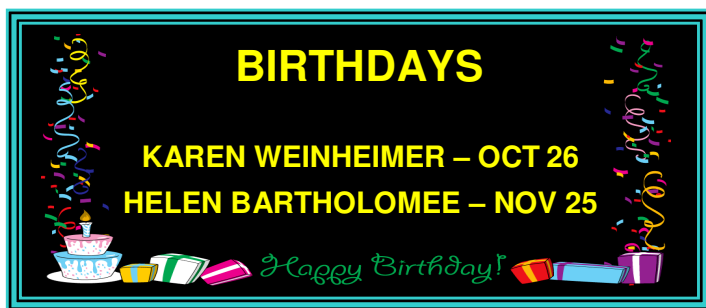
*Dear Zonta Sisters,*

Prizes are VISA Gift Cards.

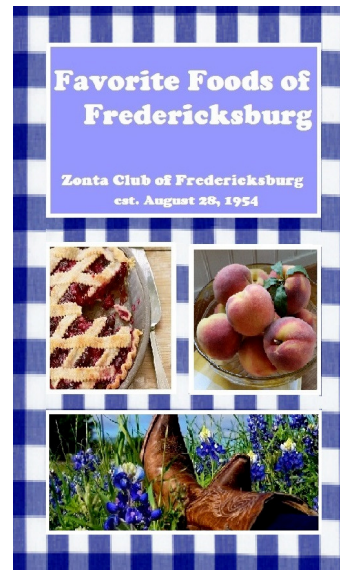
1st prize is \$1500 gift card
