A few of our Zonta sisters have seen this movie as it was shown pretty much everywhere around us except in Fredericksburg. I normally am wary of movies with violence as I tend to re-live them over and over in my dreams, late at night, when I take my walk, etc. But, when invited to go to the showing of the movie in Kerrville, I decided to Buckle up Buttercup and go. To say it was powerful, doesn't do it justice. Aside from the reality of the story and how it easily demonstrated how kids can get trapped into these abductions with no way out, I wasn't frightened from the film...instead it made me mad. How can people be so evil? How can they get away with this? What can I do to stop it?

My favorite line in the film was, "God's children aren't for sale." I think this sums up the projects that we work to undo: whether it is "selling" children into marriage, or for sex, or extorting money from them after online seduction, or keeping them in poverty, or out of education, or any violence against women and girls. All of this makes me mad. And the only way I feel I can be a part of their change is to be a part of Zonta.

August Meeting Highlights

What a celebration of talent at our August meeting! We presented Araceli Coker her "hat trick" of Young Women in Public Affairs scholarship awards. The three totaled \$7000: \$1000 each from the local and districts clubs, and \$5000 from the international organization.

Committee chair Cindy Wilson introduced our honoree, noting, "Araceli is an empowered young woman that in 18 years has met all the criteria that exemplifies the essence of Zonta: commitment to volunteerism, leadership in both student and workplace life, and astounding drive in projects to fight abuse of women."

In addition to the scholarship awards, Cindy Wilson presented Araceli with yellow roses, candy, and a certificate of accomplishment.

Her impressive list of accomplishments include:

- The Junior Reserve Officers' Training Corps (JROTC) Logistics Commander (managing a \$250,000 budget);
- JROTC Inspector General (officer in charge of inspections and cadet compliance);
- A total of 628 hours of service to the Kendall County Women's Shelter Thrift Store;
- Almost 200 hours of service at the Kerrville Veteran's Affairs Hospital learning about the organization and managing patients; and
- Additional volunteering with the Salvation Army, Joan Kroc Corps Community Center, and the Boys and Girls Club.

It's clear that Araceli is wise beyond her young years, stating that, "Empowering women is an approach that needs support by all people no matter what the gender. In my eyes by working together as a society to promote gender equality and empower women, we can create a more just and equitable society for all."

And these awards had impact! "Thanks to the scholarships from Zonta, I am able to pursue my education at my *chosen* university," she said.

Lieutenant Governor Shelly Baumgarten attended the North America Interdistrict meeting in Indianapolis, Indiana this summer and provided an update on its topic of gender equity centered around climate change. She gave us take aways and highlights from other sessions too, including how to recruit new members and create videos. She also discussed Core Competencies, a recommended curriculum for both new and long-time members. She reported nearly 200 women attended and the entire Zonta International Board was there.


