

### The "Official Christmas Gift Exchange Game" Rules

1. Each player brings one wrapped gift (**Value \$20**) to place under the tree.
2. Each player draws a number to figure in what order they will go.
3. Players sit so they can see the gift pile.
4. Player #1 selects a gift from under the "tree" and opens it. Make sure everyone get to see the gift!
5. Following sequentially, players in turn can choose to either pick an unwrapped gift or steal a previous player's gift. Anyone who gets their gift stolen in this way immediately may choose a new gift or steal from someone else as a replacement.
6. A present can only be stolen once per turn, which means players who have a gift stolen from them have to wait a turn to get it back.
7. **After two swaps of the same gift (the 3<sup>rd</sup> holder) the turn automatically comes to an end and the gift is FROZEN. Let it Go!**
8. **If, and only if,** after all players have had a turn and the first player is **still holding her original gift**, she gets a chance to swap the gift for any other opened gift that has not been FROZEN. Play Ends.






## Zonta's 16 Days of Activism is approaching!

From November 25<sup>th</sup> through December 10<sup>th</sup> and through the Zonta Says NO to Violence Against Women campaign, Zonta clubs around the world are uniting to raise their voices to bring awareness to this issue and advocate on behalf of gender-based violence survivors. Zonta International envisions a world in which women's rights are recognized as human rights and every woman is able to achieve her full potential. In such a world, women have access to all resources and are represented in decision-making positions on an equal basis with men. In such a world, no woman lives in fear of violence.

Our ZCF has big plans again to promote the awareness of this important campaign. This year we will focusing our awareness campaign in the schools of Fredericksburg and by contacting our local and state government representatives. Lisamarie has met with Dr. Joe Rodriguez, the superintendent of FSD, and he is very amenable to the projects we have planned which will be executed in the elementary & middle schools with the staff only and in the high school with the student body.

A "Walk in Her Footsteps" theme has been proposed for the high school. This project will include Orange Paper Footprints lining the main hallway at the school for a visual impact for the students to see during the 16 Days of Activism. We will place a table in the foyer decorated with our banner and an eye-catching tablecloth. On it will be a box of pre-cut orange footprints in it and sharpie markers available for the students and staff to write a word of encouragement on the footprint and then post it along the walls of the main hall. With great participation (and anticipation) we should see a wall of orange shining an awareness to "Zonta Says No to Violence Against Women." We will have a roll of orange ribbon stickers handy for everyone to wear after they have posted a footprint. Informational postcards will be available for pick up too.

In the lower grades we will have the staff Write "Relate-able Role Model" letters supporting The Girl's Empowerment Network (GEN) in Austin just like we will be doing at our November meeting. All letters will be mailed together to GEN as a group.




