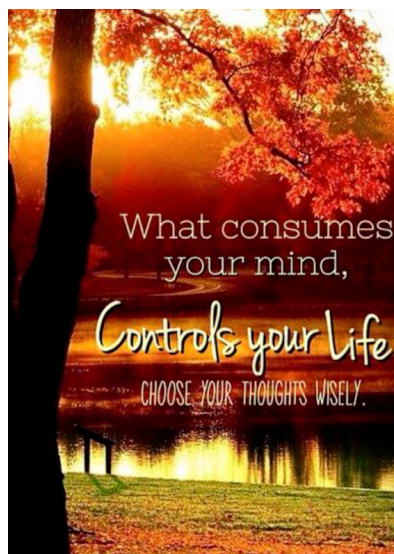

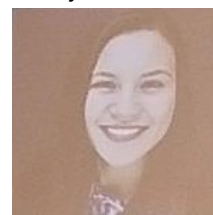
Congratulations to our 2018 District 10 STEM Scholarship Recipient

Heidi Johnson of Garland, Texas is studying at Brigham Young University with a major in Mechanical Engineering with plans for a Masters in Environmental Engineering. Her focus is to help the environment through utilization of renewable resources such as solar panels and wind turbines to creating a cleaner and more efficient world.

The STEM Scholarship application for 2019 has been updated by our District with these guidelines:

Undergraduate female student living or attending college within the District 10 geographical boundaries, currently enrolled in STEM (Science Technology Engineering Math) with no fewer than 30 college hours, with strong academic achievement, ie., 3.00 CPGA on a 4.00 scale.

Deadline for application is July 1, 2019

ZONTA HOLIDAY PARTY IS COMING!

Every ZCF member should put another date on your calendars for a "Not To Miss" occasion. Our December General Meeting to be held on Monday, December 17th will be our Christmas Party instead. This year it will be held at Cindy Wilson's home. Hostesses will be Marti Barth, Liz Wunderlich, Ginger Mitchell, Sharon Wahrmond, Peggy Lindig & Frankie Hohenberger who will supply the main dishes and drinks while our lovely membership will potluck the appetizers and desserts. This will be a fun event for all and should not be missed.

Each year we usually have a "Dirty Santa," Chinese Christmas, "White Elephant" or whichever term you prefer to go along the festivities for the evening. A maximum of \$20 gift should be purchased to participate in the gift exchange.

The rules are as follows:

1. Each player brings one wrapped gift to contribute to a pool of gifts under the "tree."
2. Each player draws a number to decide in what order they will go.
3. Players sit so they can see the gift pile.
4. The first player selects a gift from under the "tree" and opens it. Make sure everyone get to see the gift!
5. Following sequentially, players in turn can choose to either pick an unwrapped gift or steal a previous player's gift. Anyone who gets their gift stolen in this way immediately may choose a new gift or steal from someone else as a replacement.
6. A present can only be stolen once per turn, which means players who have a gift stolen from them have to wait a turn to get it back.
7. After two swaps of the same gift (the 3rd holder) the turn automatically comes to an end and the gift is FROZEN. Let it Go!
8. If, after all players have had a turn and the first player is still holding her original gift, she gets a chance to swap the gift for any other opened gift that has not been FROZEN. Play Ends.

ALSO, Bring items for the Women's Shelter

Toiletries for women, sleepwear and slippers for women, gifts for children such as, stuffed animals, puzzles, coloring books, dolls, toy cars, trucks and such. These items do not need to be wrapped so the shelter can decide where they should go. A monetary donation to the shelter is also acceptable.
