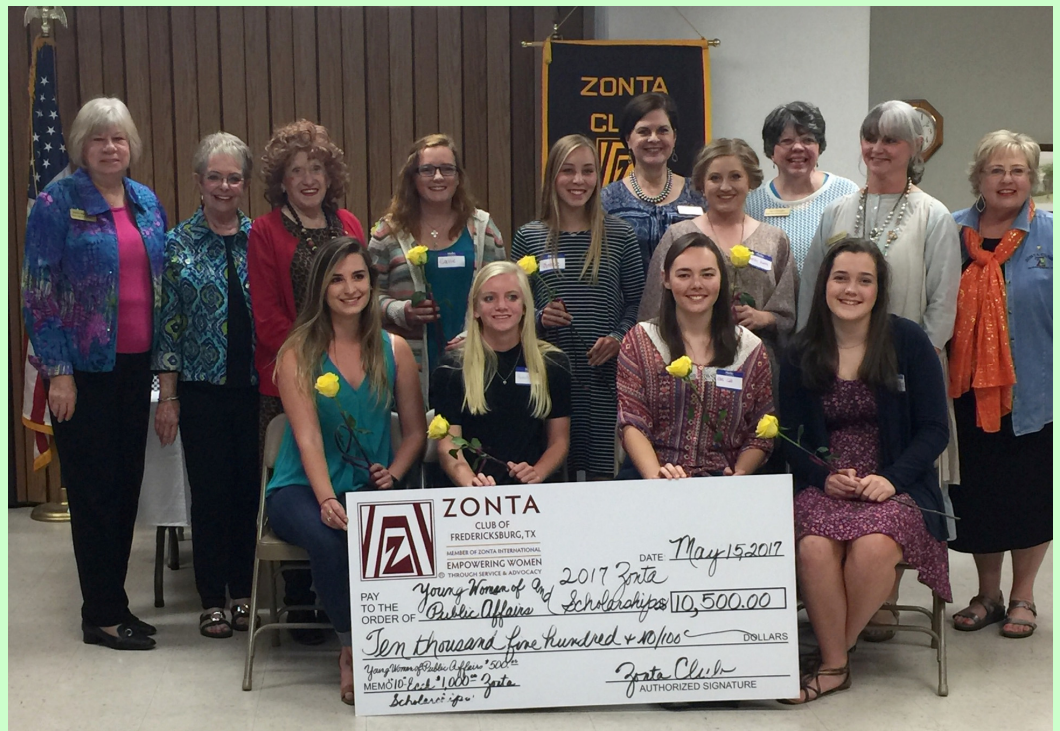
MAY MEETING RECAP

Have You Ever Heard of Equal Pay Day?

Tuesday, 4 April, was Equal Pay Day in the USA, the day when women and men around the country recognize the wage gap between working women and men, and offer remedies to address pay inequity.

The date symbolizes how far into the year women must work to earn what men earned in the previous year. According to data released by the U.S. Census Bureau in September 2016, women in the United States make 79.6 cents for every dollar men make.

Equal Pay Day shines a spotlight on pay equity in the U.S., but the gender pay gap is a worldwide problem. On average, women globally make just 77 cents for every dollar earned by men. With the current gap at 23 percent, it will take 70 years to close the gender wage gap, according to the 2016 International Labour Organization (ILO) Report Women at Work.

As an organization that works to improve the economic and professional status of women, Zonta International believes in pay equity, and finds the global gender pay gap unacceptable.

Through our advocacy work with the UN Committee and the important actions our clubs take, Zonta is working to achieve Sustainable Development Goal No. 5: Achieve gender equality and empower all women and girls. This goal will not be met until women earn equal to their male counterparts.

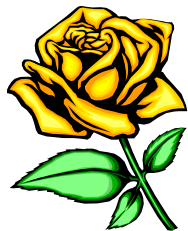
