AUGUST MEETING:

- Everce Nyamahunge, from Uganda, is Tatenda's friend who she met at Cottey College. She has been sponsored by many in the Fredericksburg community through the efforts of Nan Moseley, and she will be Yustinah's (pronounced You-Steen-ah) "big sis" at Cottey when Yustinah starts end of August. Everce (pronounce EEE-Vis) has offered to tell the story of her journey, along with Tatenda/Yustinah's at the next Zonta meeting in August. We will call it, "The empowerment of the Schoolchildren of Africa" and I've asked Everce to cover: 1) the personal journey of both families; 2) what were the big cultural differences that she had to overcome (food, clothing, music, language, weather, etc); and 3) what her dreams are for after graduation (she is in the four year Cottey program).
- Yustinah would have never made it to Cottey without the support for the last two years of the kids from Z-club. They have raised the money each year to send the tuition for the high school education for Yustinah and her sister, Hope. Because of them, she graduated and was able to get admitted into Cottey. They also sent enough money for each sister to have two school uniforms so that they could attend the schools—all sent directly to either the Methodist church (clothes) or the school so that dad couldn't get his hands on it. We are hoping that they will want to continue the project for her sister, Hope, again this year. It is an unbelievable success story from kids who wanted to personally help someone, and through Nan, we were able to get linked up with their family.
- Yustinah is coming with literally the shirt on her back. They have nothing. So, items have been collected for her in the PEO club and community, and they would welcome anything that Zonta members would like to give. Nan says that gently used clothing would be best—they don't want to overwhelm this child with all kinds of new stuff—she isn't expecting nor prepared for all that. Here are the sizes that we've been able to round up. Remember...it will be cold as hell in Missouri for fall—something she is not used to—so any jackets, wraps, gloves, leggin's, socks, sweaters, etc would be especially welcome. They have a Walmart there, so if someone wants to do a gift card, that is fine as well. Her mom sent these measurements:

Height: 5'1"
Chest: 38"
Waist: 35"
Hips: 44"
Shoe size: 8

• Yustinah arrives in San Antonio the Wed after our next meeting in August and will be in that evening and then heads to Cottey College with the group from Fbg (including Everce). If everyone could bring any items they would like to give to her to the next meeting, then Everce can take them to Nan's, and when Yustinah arrives from the airport, she can try them on at Nan's house, and take with her those that fit. Sounds like a plan??
