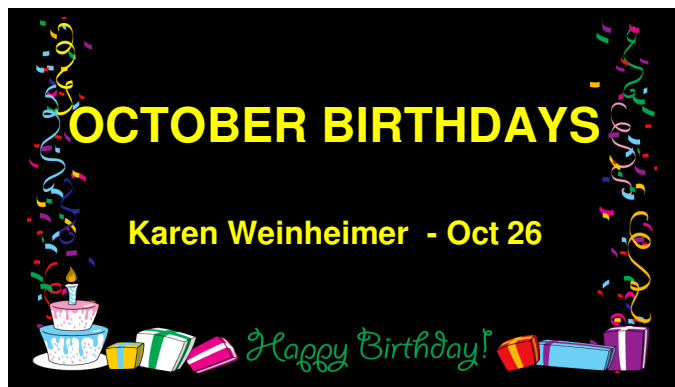

VETERAN'S DAY PARADE

The event will kick off the day with the ringing of the church bells for 1 minute, at 11:00 am, followed by a wreath laying ceremony at the War Memorial Monument. At 1:45 pm there will be a Military Aircraft Fly-over. The 2 pm Veteran's Day Parade is one that is sure to make history. Plans are going great toward the designing, creating, and building of our Zonta Club of Fredericksburg's float for this Veteran's Day celebration. What a wonderful privilege for our club to sponsor the parade float that will carry and honor the women veterans from our county. Hats off to all that are working hard on this project. Following the parade, there will be a 3:30pm WWI era music presentation at Marketplaz. Be there or be square!



Highlighting Our Advocacies, Service Projects and Fundraisers

Bylaws – This committee is responsible for the Standing Rules and the Bylaws. To keep the Club's bylaws in line with Zonta International, and to review and revise them every two years after the International Convention.

Amelia Earhart – Every January Zonta International and the Zonta Club of Fredericksburg honor Amelia Earhart on January 11th, this is known as Amelia Earhart Day. She was a member of the Zonta Club of New York when her plane went down. A Fellowship was established at the next International Convention in 1938. Today 35, \$10,000.00 Fellowships are given every year. The program in January is dedicated to honoring her. In the past we have had the privilege of one or two of the Amelia Earhart Fellow attending the January Meeting to explain what they are working on. This committee is responsible for presenting this program and if there is an AE Fellow at UT or Texas A&M, inviting them to the meeting. We have helped with travel expenses.

Membership – This committee is vital for the future of the club and for the growth of Zonta International. Define short and long-term goals in keeping with the current ZI strategic plan and International Membership Committee recommendations. Develop a plan for retaining current members and recruiting new members and design activities that will help identify new members. Identify a mentor for each new member and on-going communication for all.

Zonta Club's payment of \$260 gives Annamercy 1 year of schooling at a private school where Netsai Ndambakuwa is a teacher. Netsai is the mother of Tina and Hope—both girls were sponsored by Z-Club and Zonta. Tina is now attending Cottey College in Nevada, Missouri and Zonta collected clother for her when she arrived in the USA to go to college. Hope will graduate this year and it is anticipated that she will come to Cottey College.

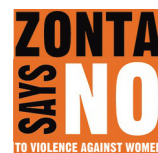
