Start planning NOW for one of THE most rewarding, FUN, and memorable trips as we, the Zonta Club of Fredericksburg, journey to and from the **2019 Zonta International, District 10 Conference** to be held in Lafayette, Louisiana. **The conference is scheduled for October 18th and 19th, 2019.** This luxury limousine bus will depart at 7:30 am, from Fredericksburg on Thursday, October 17th with an estimated arrival of 4:00 pm at Lafayette, Louisiana. The return from Lafayette will depart at 7:30 am on Sunday, October 20th arriving in Fredericksburg late afternoon.

Hotel accommodation and conference registration information for the conference will be sent to us by mid August, but transportation plans with Austin Aloha Limousine will need to be settled earlier.

The ESTIMATES on the conference expenses are: \$235 for conference registration (that's for the 2 day conference; includes lunch both days and banquet dinner on Saturday); and Hotel accommodations have priced each room with double Queen beds at \$109 (plus applicable tax) each night. We will be staying 3 nights, and if you want to share a room, never too late to find someone to help share that cost.

If you are interested in reserving one of the 10 or 12 available seats in the limousine bus, please contact Frankie Hohenberger, by text or calling, at 210-317-0740.

The estimated transportation cost per occupant, round trip, is \$275 per person. Reserved seats will be offered on a first come, first served basis. Money must be paid by August 1, 2019, NO EXCEPTIONS PLEASE. **Make checks payable to Frankie Hohenberger** as she will be the responsible party for securing this mode of transportation.

This will be a once in a life time trip to participate in celebrating Zonta's 100th birthday as well as representing our Zonta Club of Fredericksburg in grand fashion. One of our Service Projects is the Women's Job Corps. They teach new and improved job skills at "no charge" to the students.

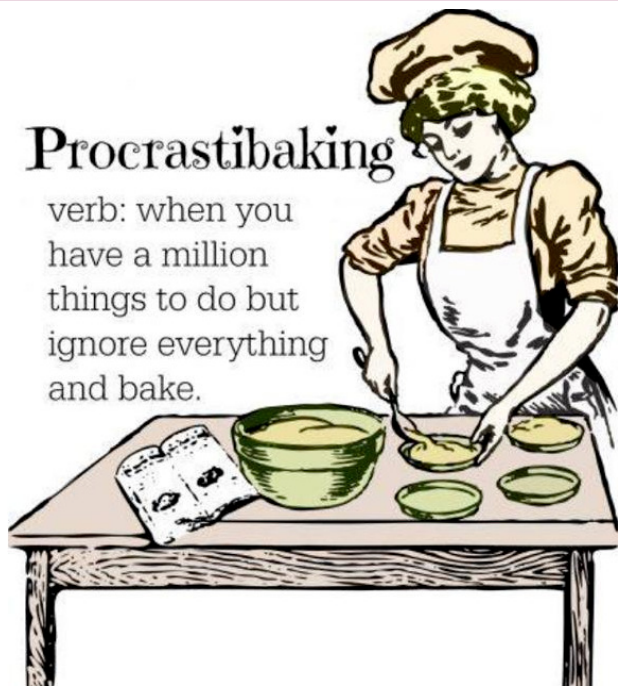

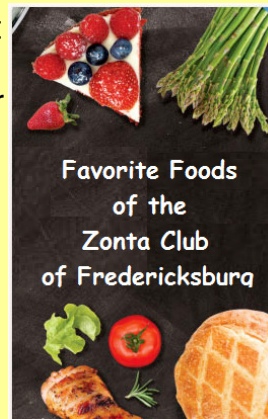
